- C. Consider accepting the Quotation from, and hiring, Northwest Interiors LLC to stucco the Trolley Station and Lee Moberly Museum buildings in an amount not to exceed \$38,008.
- D. Consider accepting the Bid Proposal from, and hiring, National Coatings Inc. to clean and repaint in April 2016 the exterior of the City's existing water storage tank for an amount not to exceed \$46,415.
