Middleton School District releases three surveys as part of a long-term strategic planning process

The Middleton School District has reached out to staff, parents, students and patrons to collect feedback on important issues to the district as it moves into a strategic planning process.

Superintendent Marc Gee said links to three separate surveys to gather opinions regarding school facilities, the funding of maintenance and building of new facilities and academic priorities were sent Friday via email and shared on Facebook in the Middleton community. The survey period will close November 23. The long-term planning process should be wrapped up next spring.

"A school district should update its strategic plan about every seven years, and as new superintendent to Middleton it's absolutely critical to assess community opinions and gather ideas for moving forward. Essentially, it provides a road map for moving forward," Gee said.

The survey data will be reviewed and committees organized to develop the strategic plan.

"With two new board members elected and taking office in January, this is the perfect time to closely examine the school district's priorities moving forward," Gee added.

District enrollment continues to grow, with even more homes in various planning stages within the district's boundaries, Gee said Middleton will need to plan for more classroom space.
