With the winter upon us, the City of Middleton wanted to provide clarity on our current policies related addressing snowfall. Our public works crews have been directed to focus their plowing on the main arterial roadways. In addition to our sanding operations, the City added the ability to use a road salt this year and we are using that product around main intersections and steep hills within the City.

You will also see our crews managing snow at City Hall, our parks, the Library, and a few other City owned facilities. Each property owner is responsible for clearing sidewalks adjacent to their own property and the City is intent on doing our part.

There are a few other public agencies working around our City too. The Idaho Transportation Department has primarily responsible for the snow plowing on SH44. And Highway District 4, formerly Canyon Highway District 4, has responsibility for most of the roads immediately outside of our City limits.

Finally, please be aware that your Middleton Public Works Staff has been working long hours in less-than-ideal conditions to keep up with the winter weather we are experiencing. Please be patient and give them a little extra space to get their job done. A thumbs up or thank you is also appreciated if you have the opportunity.
