Idaho Code 50-345 allows the City to collect a fee from users of a computerized mapping system , not exceeding the actual costs of development, maintenance and dissemination of digital forms of the system.

Actual engineering and legal expenses attributable to an application are billed to the applicant. There will be an inspection done during the 10th month of the warranty period to check warranty items, no money will be refunded until the warranty period expires.
